Graduating Seniors

Trinity Scholarship

* A one time award open to graduating High School Seniors who have been accepted into an E.L.C.A. institution of higher learning and who have been active in church, high school and community.

* Amount of the award varies.

Bertha Weiks Memorial Scholarship

* A one time award open to graduating High School Seniors attending a two or four year College or a Technical school who have been active in church, high school, and in the community.

* Amount of the award varies.

Wayne Larson Memorial Scholarship

* A one time award open to High School Seniors attending a two or four year College or a Technical school who have been active in church, high school and the community.

*Amount of the award is \$200.00.

Ladwig Scholarship

* A one-time award open to graduating High School Seniors attending a four-year College, a Junior College, or a two-year Technical/Trade school who have been active members of church and demonstrate leadership ability and involvement in the community.

*Award amount is \$500.00.

Graduating Seniors or Continuing Education

_Debbie Olson Memorial Scholarship

* Available to a High School graduate who is a member of Trinity Lutheran Church and demonstrates Trinity Church involvement and school involvement.

* Applicable to any school or college for a student pursuing any recognized program of advanced education by certificate, diploma or associated degree.

* Amount of award is \$500.00 for one year.

Andrew and Phyllis Pechacek Scholarship

* Available to a High School graduate who is a member of Trinity Lutheran Church and demonstrates Trinity Church involvement and school involvement.

* Amount of the award varies.

Ladwig Scholarship (non-traditional)

* A one-time award open a to non-traditional student over the age of 24 who is seeking his/her first degree, has been an active member of Trinity and demonstrates leadership ability and involvement in the community.

* Amount of the award is \$500.00

Berthelsen Scholarship

* A one-time award open to a High School graduating senior or non-traditional student seeking higher education.

* Amount of the award varies.
