Finance

And February it is, 2 to 3 minutes of daylight are added daily during this time of year. I'll take it and we need it, too many cloudy days lately. Below are excerpts from my 2022 annual letter to show members how the past year looked financially.

Trinity had a deficit of \$1,216 for meeting our fixed expenses and salaries in 2022. Our total disbursements were up \$10,382 from 2021. Our total offering increased by \$3,174 from 2021. The major increase in disbursements was due to the increase we have all seen in energy prices, 2022 saw a \$7,550 increase over 2021. We met or exceeded almost all our designated benevolences we budgeted for in 2022, except for the budgeted \$10,000 to the ELCA. We were \$5,041 short of fulfilling that.

We received an email from our offering envelope supplier that there are delays happening with delivering envelopes out. Production of the February envelopes was suspended. The offering envelopes will resume and be delivered by the first Sunday in March. Until then, please use an envelope from home or a temporary envelope found in the pews. Please record your member number, amount and any designations on the envelope. This will help our weekly counters with their task of tracking weekly offerings.
